## **Instructions for obtaining working papers**

Ages 14-15 (Blue Card)

Ages 16-17 (Green Card)

- 1. Please take or print one of each form.
  - a) <u>Form AT-16</u> (Physical Fitness Certification) Complete the upper portion (top 2 lines). <u>Part A</u> can be signed by either the school nurse, or a family doctor, confirming a current physical within the last year.
  - b) <u>Form AT-17</u> (Application for Employment Certificate)— Complete ONLY Part 1 for Parental Consent, which includes a Parent/Guardian signature. Please leave the rest of the form blank.
- 2. Once complete, staple these 2 forms together and bring them to Mrs. Lembo or Mr. Federbush in the HS Guidance Office. If your physical was confirmed by the nurse or your doctor, we can grant the working papers right away. Otherwise you'll have to submit an updated physical before they can sign off on it.

## **Additional Notes:**

Once you reach age 16, you will have to apply for a green working paper card, even if you already obtained a blue card prior to this.

When you leave your job, please ask your employer for the working papers back. This way we can avoid the process of writing a duplicate. Though if a duplicate is needed, please see the guidance office.
