A short essay describing how the good deeds have impacted the individual or community. Also include a statement describing what the nominee hopes to achieve with his or her abilities. The most meaningful aspects of that goal and what aspirations the nominee holds for his or her example in the future. **(Please do not include transcripts)**

4. **Letters of Recommendation**

Nominees are asked to submit two letters of recommendation. These letters should be written by a teacher, clergy or community leader who has worked directly with the nominee.

- Caring
- Equality and Social Justice
- Responsibility
- Transmission of values and identity
- Pioneering educational or community activities
- Special approaches to fellow mankind

The deadline for receipt of all material is March 1, 2023. Nominations that have not been completed and received by 5:00pm on March 1, 2023 will not be considered.
